We invite you to join with Anglia members in the glorious surroundings of the Newmarket Jockey Club, courtesy of Anglia's Jockey Club members Elizabeth and Simon Bailey.

The Jockey Club Rooms have been at the heart of British horseracing for over 250 years. As a private members club, few people have stepped inside and seen the magnificent interiors, which house an unparalleled collection of British racing memorabilia.

The head chef Dan Perjesi has chosen a seasonal autumn dinner for us which will be served in the beautiful dining room with views of the extensive gardens. If the weather is good we can enjoy our vin d'honneur on the terrace or if not, we can have pre-dinner drinks and coffee later, in the morning room surrounded by several famous paintings by Stubbs and his contemporary John Wootton and many others.

It is a privilege to dine at the Jockey Club and I know you will be delighted by the beautiful old panelled club rooms, the home of many racing traditions. Treasures valued at over £100 million are housed in these rooms.

We meet for our vin d'honneur at 7pm for dinner at 7.30.

The Jockey Club is at the bottom of Newmarket High Street next to the Post Office. The main gates to the car park will be shut, but will open automatically as you approach by car. There is ample parking in front of the main entrance.

The railway station is a 10 minute walk away, or a couple of minutes by taxi and Newmarket is on the line from Cambridge to Ipswich with a train every hour.

The Jockey Club offers bed and breakfast - again in sumptuous surroundings, to non-members. You could extend your Newmarket stay and continue the horsey theme with a visit the Horseracing Museum for instance. We currently have 5 rooms on hold at the special members' rate of £100 including breakfast
