By Road & Parking

From East or West go to Junction 11 M4 then follow Sat Nav to RG27 8NB It has a good car park.

From the South take M3 to J6 and again follow Sat Nav.

By Rail

There are regular services to Reading and from London Paddington, The west & Oxford. Please see www.nationalrail.co.uk for further details.

You will need a taxi from the station. See Below.

Taxi

- There is a Taxi rank at Reading Station, and it is c£33 journey or £8.50pp if 4.

- From Caversham it is c£35 per taxi or £9pp if 4.

We plan to run taxis from Reading and Caversham, please let us know if you want to join in.

From the South it is worth looking at Hook or Basingstoke station and then booking a Bolt or Uber or local taxi service.
