By Road & Parking

By Rail

There are regular services to Didcot from Reading and from London Paddington, & Oxford. Please see www.nationalrail.co.uk for further details.

You will need a taxi from the station. It is approximately 15 minutes by taxi from Didcot Parkway railway station. If From Didcot can you let us know as Mary Has arranged a local taxi firm for us to use.

A bus service operates to Upton from Didcot and surrounding villages. It is approximately 15 minutes by taxi from Didcot Parkway railway station.

Taxi

- There is a Taxi rank at Reading Station, and it is a c£50 journey or £12.50pp if 4.
- From Caversham it is c£45 per taxi or £11pp if 4.

We plan to run taxis from Reading and Caversham, please let us know if you want to join in.
